

UNIFORM CODE 2011-2012

As stated in Student Handbook, pages 26-28

- Students should be dressed modestly, neatly, and not radically or distracting to other students or staff (based on teacher/staff judgment)
- Clothing should be clean and in good repair
- Hairstyles and hair color should be neat, well groomed and not radical or distracting to other students or staff (based on teacher/staff judgment)

Shirts:

- White, light blue, or navy shirts, solid color- no trim (either oxford, knit, or turtleneck styles are allowed)
- No three-quarter or capped sleeves should be worn.
- Shirts must be tucked in from arrival at school until dismissal from school.
- Only plain, white, short-sleeved T-shirts are permitted underneath shirt.
- Tight fitting, snug clothing, or clothes in need of repair should not be worn.

Slacks/Trousers:

- Navy blue, beige khaki, or black dress pants are permitted.
- Pants may not have rivets or patch pockets on the outside (no top-stitching).
- No stretch pants, stirrup pants, fleece pants, jeans, hip huggers, flared pants, or low riders are allowed.
- Tight fitting, snug clothing, or clothes in need of repair should not be worn.
- Belts must be worn with all pants that have belt loops in grades 5-8. Belts must not have excessive decoration.

Shorts:

- Shorts may be worn until September 30, and after May 1.
- Shorts must also be dress style and either navy blue, beige khaki, or black.
- Shorts should be no longer than the knee, and no shorter than 4 inches from knee.
- Belts must be worn with all shorts that have belt loops in grades 5-8. Belts must not have excessive decoration.

Sweaters/Sweatshirt:

- Navy blue, red, or white solid sweaters in cardigan, crew, or V-neck styles are allowed.
- Sweaters may not be longer than the waist.
- No cropped, off the shoulder, hooded, or zipper style sweaters are permitted.
- The Queen of Angels sweatshirt is the only sweatshirt allowed.
- Uniform shirt collars must be visible underneath the sweater or sweatshirt.

Socks:

- The only colors allowed are red, white, navy blue, or black.
- Socks should be anklets, crew socks, knee socks, or full length tights (not hose).
- Socks must be to the top of the ankle and easily visible.

Shoes:

- No sandals, boots, high-wedged heels, raised sole shoes should be worn.
- Shoes should not leave black marks on the floor.
- Shoes must be closed-toe, must have a back, and should be properly tied.
- Shoes with wheels are not permitted.

Skirts/Jumpers:

- Jumpers may be worn by grades **K-3 only**.
- Skirts or Split skirts may be worn by grades **4-8 only**.
- Uniform skirts and jumpers must be ordered through School Belles catalog or SchoolBelles.com
- Skirts and jumpers may not be shorter than 2 inches above the top of the knee.

Jewelry/Make-up/Hair:

- Earrings may only be worn by girls, and should be small, post type.
- No long dangle or hoop earrings should be worn.
- Make-up, if worn, should be modest and virtually unnoticeable.
- Body piercing, except for earrings for girls, is strictly forbidden.

- Hairstyles need to be neat, well-groomed, and not distracting.
- Boys need to be clean-shaven, and hair must be worn no longer than the top of the shirt collar.

Physical Education Dress Code:

Students are asked to wear shorts and a short sleeved tee shirt. No offensive messages or designs are allowed. All students should have gym shoes that do not leave scuff marks on the floor.

Uniform violations will be handled according to policy stated in Student Handbook, page 28.
